➤ **Part One ▪ Thursday, February 11, 2010**

This session will begin with an overview of what is included in a Sustainable Management System (SMS) aka Environmental Management System (EMS) and why it is important for your company. We will review the elements of a Sustainability Policy (your Green Position Statement) and introduce process flow diagrams to help you begin to think about environmental impacts in your business.

➤ **Part Two ▪ Thursday, March 11, 2010**

This session will review process flow diagrams and introduce you to "Aspects and Impacts", the key to a successful SMS. Attendees should bring a notebook computer (if you have one) and your process flow diagrams and policy statements for review.

➤ **Part Three ▪ Thursday, April 15, 2010**

This session will include "real life" examples of a working SMS to help you better understand your "Aspects & Impacts" and help your company establish objectives and targets, your goals to building and continually improving your company's Sustainable Management System.

➤ **Part Four ▪ Thursday, May 13, 2010**

This session will start with a review of the prior three sessions and your SMS. The session will conclude with assisting participants in the application process for the Colorado Environmental Leadership Program. Those who have attended the entire four part series will also have the tools and processes in place to become a SGP Verified Printer.
